# SCHOLARSHIP WORKSHOP 2020 IMPORTANT TIPS

#### Career Center-Mrs. Latowicki

- Scholarships are for those seniors who are planning on continuing their education at, either, a 4 year or 2 year college/university or technical school.
- The scholarship list in Naviance is updated once a week, usually on Tuesdays. New scholarships will be posted at the top of the list for one week and then will be posted, in the list, in alphabetical order until the deadline passes. The scholarships are also posted on the bulletin board outside the Career Center. The new scholarships, for the week, are also posted in the Newtown Bee.
- Each scholarship is different and reading for details is important. Be mindful of deadlines. There are rarely extensions or excuses accepted if an application is late. You do not have to wait until the due date to submit or mail a scholarship application. Waiting until the due date may be problematic if you are sick, or there is a storm, etc.
- Your transcript can be found in Naviance by clicking on the About Me tab, My Stuff,
  Documents Shared With Me, Senior Documents and View. Report card and
  recommendation requests must be made at least 24 hours in advance through Mrs.
  Latowicki or a School Counseling secretary. Again, do not wait until the last minute to
  request these documents.
- Newtown HS does not send SAT or ACT scores. Official scores must be requested through the test sites. Some scholarship organizations will accept downloaded copies if copied from the website correctly. See Mrs. Latowicki in the Career Center.
- There are scholarships based on interests, religion, ethnicity, a disability, community service, GPA's, majors, etc.
- Check for scholarships through your parent/s and/or grandparents, etc. employers or organizations for which they are involved.
- Check the website of the school you plan on attending for different scholarships which might be available.
- Scholarships may reduce your financial aid. If this causes a problem, a call to the financial aid office, at the school you are attending, explaining your situation may be helpful.
- Never fill out an application in pencil
- Most scholarship applications may be downloaded from Naviance unless otherwise noted. Paper applications are available in the Career Center as specified. Some applications are through specific websites, also noted in Naviance
- Check other scholarship websites listed on your Naviance home page under links (view all from my school) i.e. Unigo, Cappex, Sallie Mae, College Week Live, Fast Web, etc.
- If you receive a scholarship, PLEASE remember to write thank you note/s to the individual/organization who offered the scholarship (especially the local scholarships). This is a very important step in the scholarship process.
- Unigo has a scholarship due 1/31 and many more due after that date. They are simple scholarship applications requiring short essays.

- There is one application for multiple scholarships where recipients are selected by Newtown HS faculty and staff. Be mindful of details:
  - **❖** The Common App
  - ❖ You select which of the 5 scholarships you want to apply for based on the criteria
  - ❖ You can apply for all of them if you meet the criteria for each scholarship
  - One essay for multiple scholarships
  - Must submit your EFC from your SAR report from FAFSA only if applying for the Frederick A. DeLuca Scholarship as noted on the application
  - ❖ Available on Naviance
